Rye residents of all ages are being encouraged to come along to the Community Centre on Saturday 3 March any time between 10am and 2pm.

Rye Town Council has organised the day to find out residents' views on Rye's services and facilities and what the community wants for the town in the future.

Organisations which will be present to discuss concerns include Action in Rural Sussex (affordable housing, rural development, supporting volunteers), Rother District Council (planning and housing advice), Sussex Police (crime prevention), Postern Gate Surgery (relocation update), Rother Environmental Group, Rye Partnership (regeneration), Rye in Bloom, Hastings & Rother Primary Care Trust (lifestyle and preventable ill-health) and East Sussex Fire & Rescue (fire safety).

The information gathered will be used to inform the development of the Rye Local Action Plan, a 12-month community consultation process addressing the needs of the town across a range of issues such as housing, transport, health, leisure and the environment. The finished Plan will list actions the community would like to see undertaken and who will be responsible for achieving them.

Town Clerk, Richard Farhall comments:


This is an ideal opportunity for residents to voice their initial thoughts on what they
