Dear Speaker

At its meeting on 13 October 2015 at Hythe, town council offices a small group of members were tasked with updating the visitor leaflet. This to be completed by Easter 2016.

The leaflets have been hugely popular with visitors to member towns, and have encouraged visitors to one of the towns to explore some or all of the others. Indeed, they have been so popular the supply is now exhausted, hence the need to update and re-print the leaflet.

The proposal will need each member town to contribute to the printing and distribution costs, estimated to be in excess of £2,000-£3,000. The Speaker indicated at the meeting that Hythe would contribute to the cost of producing the leaflet and it is hoped that other member towns could be persuaded to help.

We have enclosed the 'current' leaflet for your information. Kevin Boorman will contact you in the near future for your updated information to be published in the new leaflet.

However, we cannot make a start until we have the funding in place. We are suggesting a sum of £400 to be paid by each member town although if this sum is too much then we would be grateful for a smaller donation (but still have to cover all the costs, of course). Of course most member towns have their own Tourist Information Centres which have their own budget. In which case we would ask you to forward this letter to them for their consideration.
