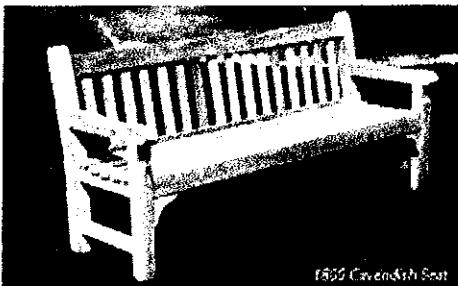

Do you want a new bench or just plaques? Basic costs are below.

A new bench with plaques, installed, would be £979.40, this is for a hardwood Cavendish bench – see the image below, provided by Streetmaster UK. This does not include a 10 year maintenance charge as I presume your steward would maintain the benches. The bench comes in a range of stains and varnishes as well.



For the two plaques the cost would be £145 for supply and installation.
