Dear Sir/Madam,

East Sussex County Council, Brighton & Hove City Council and the South Downs National Park Authority have jointly produced a consultation draft Waste and Minerals Sites Plan. This Plan sets out where waste and minerals development may take place to meet the requirements contained within the Waste and Minerals Plan, adopted in February 2013. The Plan also safeguards existing sites which are already contributing to the management of waste or production of minerals within the Plan area. We are now seeking representations from all stakeholders and members of the public on the soundness and legal compliance of the Draft Waste and Minerals Sites Plan, over a period of eight weeks.

Comments should be made between 28 October and 23 December 2015. The Draft Plan and a full set of supporting documentation can be found at our online consultation portal <http://consult.eastsussex.gov.uk>.

How do I find out further information on the Draft Plan?

There are four categories of sites identified in the Draft Plan: Allocation of sites for potential waste uses; Areas of Opportunity on previously developed or allocated land; Areas of Search; and Expansion to Existing Waste Sites. A draft policy is also proposed on existing industrial sites which may be suitable for waste development within the Plan area.

A guide to help you identify whether there are identified sites of interest related to you is attached to this letter. A schedule of existing industrial estates which may be suitable for waste development has also been produced and is available to view on the consultation portal.

Officers will be providing drop-in sessions at select libraries, should you wish further information. A list of dates for these drop-in sessions is attached.

How do I make representations?

Our online consultation portal <http://consult.eastsussex.gov.uk> has been designed to make submitting comments via a website much easier and we encourage its use. Anyone can view the proposed consultation draft documents on the portal but to make comments you will need to have a username.
