Hello Richard,

I have been out all afternoon only to return home at five to find my mother in a state of great distress about the hotel and the traffic.

The George Hotel didn't get their rubbish collected this morning so it sat in their entrance way from early morning till lunch time. Apart from being unsightly and antisocial this is presumably obstructing their primary fire exit.

Some time in the afternoon a skip lorry stopped outside here and the operators used the skip lift to empty the hotel bins. This is a totally unsuitable vehicle for loading in this street and the noise, vibrations and the close proximity of the crane terrified my mother. In the meantime all the traffic all the way round into East Street was jammed. Eventually in frustration many drivers including those with goods vehicles forced their way past the skip lorry down the side of the house and the front of The Golden Fleece shop.

Additionally, as you know and presumably most councillors are now aware all the regular delivery drivers for the hotel have resumed using this street from early in the mornings till lunch time six days a week, despite the provision of the loading bay.

I have absolutely had enough of all these ongoing problems!!

In the light of this today I am now formally requesting that we can have metal bollards placed outside this property to protect the house, ourselves and visitors. Arguments about the lack of space on the pavement are nonsensical, as I note that these have already been placed on narrow sections of pavement in other locations such as the opposite the top of Conduit Hill and in The Mint. I would be most grateful if you could arrange a site visit from East Sussex Highways to assess the matter urgently.
