7	For what purpose or project is the grant requested?	We are looking to purchase air con units. This summer particularly we have struggled to keep our classrooms cool enough or to a safe level that we have had to close the setting. This means nursery loses money and our parents cannot work. Safer sleep guidance asks us to keep rooms to a temp of 18-20. Our sleep room hasn't been below 24 in the last 4 weeks. We have purchased some air coolers and new fans, but we need more robust machines to help bring the temperature down. I have been looking into decarbonation grants etc through the government but i am yet to be successful on this. Your town Clerk Amy has also kindly been looking for us and unfortunately was unable to find anything currently.

		As charity setting, I'm sure your aware we do not make a profit for us to purchase such items. We will be fundraising in September however we are hoping will go towards our upstairs toilets as they are in desperate need of an upgrade, and the heat will be gone by then i would imagine. I have been looking at the more robust units - (whilst lots of places are sold out – these are more effective than what we have currently. The price ranges from £300 - £500 per unit and i believe we would need around 4 of them. Any amount from the council to go towards this would be so greatly appreciated. Ideally going forward, we would like to have air con permanently fitted but this cost is far above what we can afford unless we were to be successful with a large grant. We do not like to let our parents down – especially when they are working.
